CLEANING MINISTRY FAQ's

WHEN DO I COME TO THE CHURCH FOR CLEANING?

You can come anytime on Friday until 3:00pm or you can come Saturday morning or early afternoon. Most people come early on Saturday morning.

CAN I COORDINATE WITH OTHER PEOPLE ON THE SCHEDULE?

Yes! You can email or give them a call to see what is a good time for you all to work together.

WHAT DO I DO FIRST?

Inside the men's bathroom is a closet that has the Church Cleaning Task List on a white board on the inside of the door. This board will tell you what things have been done and what things need to be done. If the date is from the last weekend, erase the entire board and write the new date. Then make sure you check off each chore after it is completed. To see the various chores before you go to the church, you may want to download the PDF file on the ministry page titled "Church Task List."

WHERE DO I START?

The most important items would be the bathrooms and sanctuary. (Please remember the nursery bathroom!) Pick an area and begin there. Do what you can in the time you have. Remember to check off what you have done on the Church Cleaning Task List white board in the men's room closet. If those things have already been done, just do anything that has not been checked off.

DO I BRING MY OWN SUPPLIES?

No. There is a closet in the main hallway that contains various cleaning supplies. There is also a closet to the far right that contains brooms, dust brooms, and a vacuum. Many people prefer to bring Platex gloves for bathroom cleaning. Please note on the white board if we are low on supplies.

WHAT IF I CAN'T VOLUNTEER ON MY DAY?

We depend on the help of our volunteers and count on them for their efforts. But emergencies do arise. *In the event that you cannot volunteer on your day, please refer to the online Church Cleaning Schedule to find someone with whom you can switch your day.* Then please notify John Baiera at 631-553-0702 of the switch so we can change the calendar.
