Nursery Policy & Procedures for Parents

Mission Statement:

Our mission is to provide a safe, clean and fun atmosphere for your child. More importantly, we are the ministry to receive your child at their young ages. Therefore, it is our greatest desire to provide a biblically educational and worshipful experience whenever the nursery is open.

Drop-off & Pick-up Procedures

- A nursery attendant will greet you at the front door to receive your child and diaper bag
- You will sign in your child
- Please indicate if your child has any special needs or allergies at each check-in
- Your child will be released to the adult who checked in the child unless special instructions are given at check-in
- No siblings checking in or out please

Sick Policy:

For the protection of our children:

- No runny noses
- No fresh colds
- Fever-free for 24 hours
- No rashes (other than diaper rashes)
- No persistent coughs
- No diarrhea

Age Appropriate Snacks:

Snacks are provided for children old enough to sit up on their own

- INFANTS & CRAWLERS – cheerios
- WALKERS – animal crackers
- 2 YEAR OLDS – goldfish or pretzels

Checking on Your Child:

- Feel free to check on your child anytime. Please do so discretely so your child will not see you.
- We will make three attempts to calm a child that is crying. If we are unable to do so, the adult signed-in will be alerted to pick up the child.

Nursing Mothers:

Nursing mothers are welcomed to come to the nursery for privacy at anytime. Please check in at the front door and we will prepare a seat for you.
